



Oktoberfest CJLA Market Show Rules

CJLA & OPEN MARKET GOAT & WETHER DAM SHOW

Show will be **SATURDAY AFTERNOON** following **ABGA Breeding Show #1**

Weigh In/Check In: Sat., 11/4 from 12:30 pm – 1:30 pm • All Goats must be weighed in by 1:30 pm

Market Show will **start with Market Showmanship** (ages~see below)

Costume Contest: after conclusion of the CJLA Market Goat Show

APPROX. DIVISIONS: PROSPECT: 30-54 lbs, PROGRESS 55-75 lbs, MARKET 76 lbs and above
WETHER DAM CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED BY WEIGHT and will follow Market Show.
(Show committee reserves the right to adjust divisions as weigh-in breaks as necessary)

NOTES: All animals will be weighed and then entered into weight classes, broken down by Prospect, Progress and Market. There will be a Champion & Reserve in each division with an Overall Supreme. Following the market show, there will be classes of **Wether Dams** in which CHAMPION & RESERVE WETHER DAM will be awarded. The Show Committee will award as much as possible back to jackpot exhibitors.

SANCTIONING ORGANIZATION: CJLA is sanctioning the market show. EARLY ENTRY FEE on or before 10/28/17: \$30.00 per entry. \$5 STALL FEE: \$5.00 per stall which includes first bedding; it is optional to show out of your trailer.

LATE FEE: Entry forms received after 10/28/17 (including day-of sign-up) will incur an additional late fee of \$5.00 per head.

If necessary, you may email entries and payment will be accepted at the show.

HEALTH REGULATIONS: Health Certificates are not required, (unless goats are from out-of-state.) Goats showing **ANY** visible signs of illness will be removed and disqualified at the sole discretion of the show officials; i.e. fungus, ringworm, sore mouth, pneumonia, external parasites, or other disease, illness. PLEASE DON'T BRING IT TO THE SHOW. We reserve the right to have a Licensed Veterinarian or show official present to inspect each animal before it crosses the scale. The sole discretion of the show officials and/or veterinarian will be final.

GENERAL RULES

- a. All JUNIOR market goat exhibitors must be under 19 years of age as of January 1, 2017. Exhibitors do NOT have to be a CJLA member to exhibit in the Oktoberfest CJLA Market/Wether Dam Show.
- b. The management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.
- c. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal (no handlers allowed) unless exhibitor has more than one goat entered in the same class.
- d. Each exhibitor must be in control of his/her animal at all times.
- e. Market goats can be wethers (castrated males) or does. No bucks allowed.
- f. Animals should be clipped and clean.
- g. Animals preferably will be disbudded, dehorned or horns tipped; however, horns will be allowed.
- h. All goats must have their baby teeth to be eligible to show in the market show. No yearling teeth allowed.
- i. All paperwork and signed entry form must be completed before 1:30 pm on Saturday. Animals not entered in the show CAN NOT be on the grounds.
- j. All exhibitors are responsible for their own animals. However, a night security will be on the grounds on Friday/Saturday nights.
- k. The Oktoberfest Boer Goat Show Committee, CaMGA, Stanislaus County Fairgrounds, Bill or Sue Hobby & family, CJLA, or ABGA will NOT be held responsible for illness, injury, damage or loss of animals, person or property.
- l. Animals shown in the market /wether dam show are **ineligible** to show in the ABGA/Commercial Shows.
- m. No refunds will be made after the entry deadline of 10/28/17. No refund will be granted for disqualified entries or entries scratched after the entry deadline.
- n. All animals MUST have water in their pens.
- o. See breeding show rules for additional general rules.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST: An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 60 days of show.

SHOWMANSHIP

The market goat showmanship is open to only market animals meeting the requirements for market entries. You MUST have an animal entered in the market goat show to be eligible to show in showmanship.

Age breaks: Pee-Wee Under 9; Junior 9-12; Intermediate 13-15; Senior 16-19 as of January 1, 2017.

STALLS – No assigned stalls unless deemed necessary by the show committee. Please indicate if you have other breeders/showmen that you want to be housed close to and we will do our best to accommodate your request should an assigned stalling chart need arise. It is acceptable to show out of your trailer.
